As I grew older I still refused to submit to the Lord. I started using meth, pills, you name it I'd done it. My life had spiraled completely out of control. I was extremely selfish and caused a lot of hurt to my family and kids. I was out of chances with probation, the law, and my family. Now I thank God for sending me here, to Project New Start, for another chance. I've only been here for 2 months and already feel like a brand new person. I'm renewed, redeemed, restored, and delivered. I have finally found true peace through Jesus Christ and the wisdom through Him to know that my success comes from being aware of the enemy. I'm extremely excited to see what God has in store for me as I embrace this journey on the narrow path seeking Him diligently and with obedience. My goal when I leave here is to get into ministry work and be his helping hands. I thank the Lord for all my trials for without them I wouldn't have the strength and perseverance that I have, and to God be the glory, because without him I am nothing.

Growing up I had a good home life, and a family who loved me. I was a sheltered child. The friends I grew up with got wild as we grew older. I started drinking and smoking pot at 14, and by the time I turned 15 I had made my way to meth and pills. For almost 4 years I went behind my family's back, lying to them and hurting them. By the time I was 18, I had went off the deep end. I got arrested in December of last year. My mom got it lined out to come here, to Project New Start. Since I got here, God has been blessing me in all kinds of ways. My family started trusting me again, and they have all grown closer to the Lord, just as I have. Not only has God brought me through my addiction through this program, but he has worked in my father's life as well. I'm proud to say my father has been two months alcohol free and I have been six months sober. I now have a plan, a purpose in life, and I plan to shine my light and show others what Christ has done for me.

"My name is Katelynn. I'm sixteen years old. I am a recovered addict. My parents split up when I was a baby and my mom hasn't been stable since. She is on dope, in and out of relationships, and constantly moves around. I have spent 6 1/2 months in rehab and 2 months in JDC waiting for a bed to open. In 2016 I ran away from my dad's and starting smoking pot and doing pills. I got in a relationship that was no good for me and together we got into a lot of trouble. We both got sent off and then when I got back I got in another relationship. Again it was the same thing. This time I done so many pills that I overdosed. I went into cardiac arrest at 14 because of this. I went into rehab but when I returned home I got back on it again. I was in and out of people's houses and I didn't realize I had hit rock bottom until I was arrested the last time. I had lost everything including myself and should have been dead after all of that. My mom still isn't stable but I have gotten help. I still have bad days and good ones but I am making it. Since coming to New Life Children's Home I've grew closer with God and I begun to understand that I have a purpose in life and it is all because of God. Thanks to this place because I wouldn't have ever got this far in life. I have made a complete 360 in life and I never thought I could change." God Bless.
